ORDER No 323

In continuation to the letter No. 536 issued on 19th March 2020 and in context of the orders issued by the various Districts under Section 144 of the CrPC, the ANIDCO authorities (for South Andaman and the North & Middle Districts) and the EHL for the Nicobar District, are required to issue POL (MS/HSD) to the following:

- 1) Government vehicles (UT/Central/PSU) engaged in providing essential services which shall be certified by the Secretary (GA) for UT Administration. For Central Govt. departments permit will be issued for one vehicle per department.
- 2) Private vehicles engaged in Govt. duty and discharging essential service. The Concerned Secretary/Head of Department shall certify that the vehicle has been engaged for official use for discharging essential service. On production of the certificate, a special permit will be issued by the office of the concerned Deputy Commissioner, which will be shown to the ANIDCO outlet.
- 3) For private vehicles engaged in essential services i.e. for transporting medicine grocery/kirana item/ milk/ perishable food items/vegetables/ fruits/ meat products, cash delivery vans of banks, a special permit shall be issued by the concerned Deputy Commissioner, on application by the owner of the establishment. Only one permit will be issued per establishment.
- 4) One permit for POL shall be issued by the Director(Transport) for media persons (up to a maximum of 10) on the recommendation by the IP&T Department.
- 5) Ambulances, hearse vehicles, conservancy vehicles, vehicles of doctors on duty. They shall apply for the special permit to the concerned Deputy Commissioner.
- 6) Vehicles engaged in transporting cargo pertaining to food items/ milk/ grocery/ kirana items related to discharge of essential services from the harbor/jetty to the respective godown/store. The concerned persons engaged in this activity are to apply for a permit to the concerned Deputy Commissioner, who shall assess the overall requirement for the said applicant and issue permit to the barest minimum required.

Each permit shall entitle issuance of 15 liters of fuel per permit except for category No.06 which shall be 25 liters for local use and full tank for transporting to N & M Andaman District or return.




The business hour is restricted to one hour on daily basis from 11:00 AM to 12:00 noon until further orders.

Sir,

The World Health Organization has recently declared the Novel Corona virus (COVID-19) as a pandemic. The Government of India has been issuing various advisories, instructions, orders, etc. from time to time, to contain the spread of Novel Corona Virus (COVID-19) in the nation and there is an urgent need to impose social distancing measures by way of an abundant precaution to prevent any outbreak of the disease in the nation.

In this regard, the Competent Authority has decided to impose a ban on the sale of MS (Petrol) and HSD (Diesel) to the General Public with effect from the mid-night of 19/03/2020 till the mid-night of 26/03/2020. It is, therefore directed that during this period, POL shall only be issued to the ANIIDCO outlets.

Sir,

This is in continuation of this Directorate's letter No: DCS/LM/73/EC/2017/536 dated 19th March, 2020 imposing a ban on sale of MS (Petrol) and HSD(Diesel) to the General Public with effect from the Midnight of 19.03.2020 till the Midnight of 26.03.2020 enforcing social distancing measures by way of an abundant precaution to prevent any outbreak of the disease in the UT of Andaman & Nicobar, it is to intimate that in the case of Car Nicobar POL Retail Outlet run by EHL, Tribal Co-operative Society shall issue POL products i.e. MS (Petrol) and HSD (Diesel) for Govt. Vehicles (UT/Central/PSU) and vehicles performing essential services in Car Nicobar. For private vehicles engaged in Govt. Duty/performing essential services, fuel shall be issued only on production of a special permit obtained from the Office of the Deputy Commissioner, Nicobar District for which a detailed instruction is being issued separately.
